This is the place where leaders and ministries from all over the world who are involved with Jewish evangelism come, in order to connect, and I even had a "HIT session" (thanks to *Bob Mendelsohn*) introducing the vision and concept of HIT. Attending this conference was a great opportunity to catch-up with some old friends and especially with making MANY new contacts ALL over the world to further expand *HIT international*.

I wanted to do some promotion for *HIT international* during the Feast of Tabernacles, a time of the year where Jerusalem is flooded with Christian lovers of Israel but went instead to north of Germany and to the Netherlands (from 2-14 October 2015) in order to establish HIT there as I was requested to do so by *Asaf Pelled*, an Israeli believer, originally from a Kibbutz in Southern Israel, living in the Netherlands. On returning to Israel I only had a few days in Israel where I was able to fit a meeting with my friend *Erez Soref*, the president of

the ICB (*Israel College of the Bible*) and also with *Joseph Magen* of <http://kehilanews.com/> - both meetings went great and I look forward for further co-operation that will bear, I believe, much fruit in the coming future. I left Israel on 18 October 2015 arriving to Sydney, Australia on the 20th early in the morning where I met with *Della Brown* and together we flew to Tasmania in order to establish the HIT network there. I'll be returning to New Zealand sometime in November for yet again, another new tourist season and, if everything goes according to plan, I'll be back in Australia around mid. January 2016 for another 4 month tour to further expand the work I begun there. More about my tours of the Netherlands and northern Germany and in Tasmania - in my next newsletter.

KAM: Attached is KAM's *January 2015* and *November 2015* newsletters. In recent years, I have visited Victor every time I visited Israel and was privileged to talk to him often on the phone on various topics relating to business, missions and the Word of God. I remember asking Victor once: 'When do you rest, Victor?' and his reply was: 'I will have eternity to rest, Omri...' - Rest in peace now, Victor, and I look forward to seeing you someday, again."

www.HITinternational.net: On 28 October 2014 the 3 most important features - the list of hosts, the search engine and the online payment were added in the HIT website that was officially launched. As we expected, the transitional period of moving from one method of operation to another has not been easy for both Israeli travellers and HIT hosts who were used to a printed directory, which you can hold in your hands. Some hosts and Israelis have made their complaints known to us regarding their preference of the printed directory, but there will be no turning back to "the old way". It is true, at times, we had some problems with the new HIT website (too slow to download, very hard to navigate in order to find hosts) which we have anticipated beforehand. Like other things you start anew, there's always some "birth pangs" but overall, I believe we have provided good solutions (at least temporal ones) to problems that have risen during the season. I must say that at times I was frustrated as well, but, once again, when I compare the pro and cons of the

HIT website to the printed HIT directory there's no comparison and the new system offers us so much more. Some of the advantages are: **(1)** First and foremost, it enables us to expand the HIT network internationally, and we already have the first HIT hosts in the *USA, Canada, Mexico, Brazil, Peru, Argentina, South Africa, Austria, Portugal, Norway, Finland, Sweden, Germany, Holland, Ireland, England, Croatia, Bulgaria, Turkey, Nepal, India, Japan, Cambodia, Hong Kong, Thailand* and *Israel*. **(2)** We are able to add new hosts and services throughout the year and instantly remove those who are no longer able to host. **(3)** The promotion of the HIT network is much easier now and we are able to reach far and beyond anything we knew before, sending direct links to both Israeli travelers and prospective hosting and service providers showing interest with HIT. **We would greatly appreciate HIT hosts helping us with promotion of the HIT network in every country possible.** The more hosts we have - the sooner the Israelis will start using the HIT network in other countries outside of New Zealand.

Username and Password: Please send us a *Password* of your choice (which you'll be able to change later on) and we'll send you your *Username* so you can log-in onto our website and view your online hosting profiles. Being logged-in, will also enable you to access an area where you'll be able to view online, the Membership Cards of HIT members who contact you in order to come and stay with you. This is vitally important for your own protection as hosts.

www.facebook.com/groups/hit.nz - The HIT facebook group is where hosts and Israelis can connect and share with one another with photos and stories, and where I constantly post various items regarding my whereabouts and of news and updates regarding the HIT network, so you can be kept informed with up-to-date information. HIT international hosts and supporters can be part of this group, so please send us a request to join in. Please note, however, that this group is first and foremost for Israeli travelers (who are non-believers) and too much of a "Christian talk" is a turn off to them.

Dear TEOTE supporter,

It's been more than a year since our previous newsletter (September 2014). In this newsletter I'll try to cover the main things that have happened in the HIT network during that time. I will also touch a bit on my plans for the coming year. I returned to New Zealand on 1 October 2014, the first season for the HIT network without a printed directory, but a new international website instead (**www.HITinternational.net** more about it further down this newsletter). After a number of months of over-seeing the transitional period up-close "in the field", the time has come to establish HIT Australia. Together with New Zealand, Australia is the only English-speaking, Western country in the world that Israelis go to as backpackers! Every Israeli coming to New Zealand has heard about HIT and about 80-90% of those Israelis are traveling to Australia as well. 500 Israelis each year can now get a one-year Working Holiday Visa in Australia. Israelis coming to New Zealand for 3 months can stay up to 90% of their time in HIT homes. Just imagine if I can create a similar network in Australia as well... We're not talking of only 3 months of input that God can invest into the lives of these travelers but 6 months and even longer. Can you see why I am so excited about HIT Australia?!? The possibilities there are huge!

Operating in New Zealand since February 2000 with 500 host families and 1,800 people on our mailing list - the HIT network is very well established here. Touring New Zealand is easy. New Zealand, like Israel, is very small. Everywhere I go there are people to accommodate me, feed me and help with arranging home groups and speaking engagements for me. However, how would I go about establishing the HIT network in Australia since I only have 20-30 contacts in the entire continent? Where do I start? How do I go about this? Whom will be able to help me? How am I going to cover my costs? These were just some of the questions that went through my mind. I must confess that in the natural sense, I was hesitant to go. However, believing it was the Lord Himself who had put Australia on my heart, I committed the situation into His hands: "If this is of you, Lord, You must go before me and prepare the way, as I cannot do it myself" was my prayer. The next thing I did was to send an email to those contacts I had in Australia asking whom would be able to help (how and where) and see IF and WHAT door/s will be open... *Peter & Noeline Jensen* (Perth, WA) got back to me right away, apologizing for the fact that they cannot help me at all, apart of providing me with a car for my travels... I didn't want to use too much of my Israeli "chutza" and so I waited for a week before replying to their email, thanking them for their generous offer and asking: "When you said that I can use your car, did you mean only in Perth; around WA, or all over Australia?" (I added a short prayer and pressed "send!"). Less than 5 minutes later I got the reply "Omri, you can take the car all over Australia..." That was all I needed! This alone will save me a week or two looking for a car and a few thousand \$\$\$ as well, but most importantly, it was the assurance I needed from the Lord that it was indeed of Him. Moreover, it meant that I would start my tour from Perth and from there would go through *Adelaide to Melbourne, Canberra, Sydney, Brisbane* and *Cairns* covering a huge distance but also the main populated areas of Australia.

I arrived in Perth on 11 February 2015 and started my tour of Australia trusting the Lord to direct me to the people and places He desired, closing doors that no man can open and opening doors that no man can shut... What can I say, I truly had an A-M-A-Z-I-N-G adventure! There's not enough space here to mention everyone that I met on my journey, but I would like to use this opportunity and personally thank all those who have hosted me and arranged meetings for me and also to those who came to hear what I had to share regarding HIT international.

I have shared quite a bit of my Australian adventures on facebook, and will use the opportunity to mention some of the highlights here:

On the Nullabor Plains I had a hot date with... a Kangaroo and the car I was given was damaged. I managed to drive it the next 1,300Km to Adelaide but when I got to the panel beater the car was written-off by the insurance company because repairing the car would have cost more than what the car was worth... I expected this to be the news and so I asked for the Lord's help. 10 minutes after I received the news about the car being written-off I received a call from *Shayne Higgins* who helped me with contacts in Adelaide. I told him about my car, and he said "I'll call you back in 10 minutes. I think I have the right car for you from people I know from my church!" To make a long story short, I ended up having a far-better car than what I had and *Peter & Noeline* who insured their car for more than its worth, got a full-refund for their money. This also meant that now I had my own car and that I didn't need to worry about how to bring it back from Brisbane to Perth... Indeed God had it all under His control!

On the Great Ocean Road, at Apollo Bay, I met *Nimrod*, an Israeli who used HIT while traveling in New Zealand. Loving his HIT experiences so much, *Nimrod* said that depending on time, he may be able to create an application for HIT *free of charge* upon his return to Israel. *At a Passover in Canberra (arranged by *Robert & Eleanor Miles*) I met *Nurit*, an Israeli woman who came to faith just a week before, and *Yonatan*, an Israeli believer in Messiah who moved there with his Australian wife in 2007. * I had the privilege to share at the *Evangelical Sisterhood of Mary* just out of Sydney (near Campbelltown) and to spend a whole day at the *Bruderhof Community of Danthonia* near Elsmore in NSW...

During my travels I was so overwhelmed with work that I often joked saying that I don't need a secretary but rather 3 secretaries who will work in shifts of 8 hours each. Since I have already decided to return to Australia for 4 more months next year (as of January 2016), I knew that I would not be able to do it on my own. I started to pray and think to myself - who can I take with me on the road? When in Bingara, NSW, I met *Della Brown* who was very helpful in giving me many contacts along the East Coast of Australia. *Della*, who volunteered with *Trumpet of Salvation* in Israel back in 2006 has first heard about HIT while staying with HIT hosts as she was touring New Zealand with *Covenant Players*, a Christian acting ministry. Being passionate about the Salvation of Israel, having a secretarial background and loving being on the road in a travelling ministry, I invited *Della* to join me for the last 2.5 weeks of my Australian tour to see how we got along and if joining my Australian tour the following year, is an option. *Della* is the easiest person to get along with; the way she's able to interact with different people is amazing and together with her various skills, contacts and knowledge of Australia she has been a tremendous blessing to me. Yes, I think I finally got myself a PA!!!

I finished my Australian tour in Brisbane and flew to Israel, arriving there on May 21st. Apart of visiting with family and friends and having some very much needed time for R&R, I used my time in Israel for some study and mainly to connect with as many people in the Body of Messiah in Israel and with as many congregations and ministries in the land, looking for ways for cooperation. There was also much work to do on the HIT website and to also establish a website for TEOTE ministry (see more, further down this newsletter). The 10th annual *Lausanne Consultation on Jewish Evangelism* (LCJE) Conference was held in Jerusalem (16-21 August 2015).
